It is not only and

not so much about the salary, but about the opportunity to work on the unique equipment and under the guidance of scientists known in their field well beyond Russia. As practice shows, this is the main motivation for a young scientist, who decided to go to a Siberian university,—said **Eugene Vaganov** — SibFU will sign three-year contracts of specific work with the selected candidates."
