

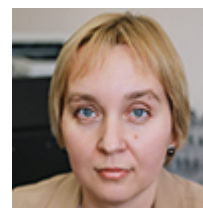
# SibFU scientists speak at the forum on digital technologies in the academic environment

On 25 November 2021, the second scientific and educational forum started in Novosibirsk within the framework of TRANSFER OF KNOWLEDGE. FUTURE TECHNOLOGIES joint scientific and educational project by the Knowledge Society and IPR MEDIA company.



Researchers from Siberian Federal University gave their talks on educational practices in the field of popularizing digital technologies in universities. Lectures by experts from the School of Philology and Language Communication and the School of Space and Information Technology were devoted to trends in the use of artificial intelligence, virtual and augmented reality, and machine learning.

The forum also listened to Elena Chistova, head of the Department of Oriental Languages of the School for Philology and Language Communication, who spoke on the dialogue system of simultaneous interpreters, and a lecture on intelligent technologies of information and analytical control systems by Dmitry Perfiliev, assistant professor of the Department of Artificial Intelligence Systems.

The forum was attended by rectors and researchers from leading Siberian universities, including Tomsk State University, Tomsk State University of Control Systems and Radioelectronics, Omsk State University, and Novosibirsk State Technical University.

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
