The round-table discussion of the Workshop was devoted to joint research projects, International Summer Schools, students and staff internships, double degrees programs, etc. The following working groups were formed:

- 1. Permafrost and Paleoclimate Network for Eurasia;
- 2. Mechanisms of Plant and Ecosystem Responses to Environmental Change;
- 3. Dendroclimatology and remote sensing.

<u>Memorandum of Understanding</u> and <u>Memorandum of Agreement</u> between participating institutions were developed and signed after the Workshop.
